GLOBAL ENVIRONMENTAL BALANCES

Since the second half of the 20th century, degradation of global ecological balances led by environmental pollution due to the unconsciously overuse and consumption of the natural resources, has become a major problem.

Clearly, most of the natural resources, being foundation stones of economic development and growth, are vulnerable assets and it is almost impossible to recuperate them. So, today, it is an obligation to apply the environmental socio-economic development policies in the context of sustainability. In other words, the sustainability and the existence of life on earth depend on the development of urgent global policies which are truly based on harmonious ecological and economic ethics.

With these reasons, the theme of the Ecocity 2009 Conference, "Global Environmental Balances", focuses on finding new approaches towards a new ecologically oriented world order for future generations. Besides underlining the importance of eco-thinking, ethics, eco-politics and the methods to reach an ecological awareness, issues such as spatial planning policies and natural resource management, energy provision technologies, eco-architecture and design and environmentally friendly building materials will also be discussed by scientists, politicians and environment experts in the perspective of the third millennium.

To this end, following sub-topics of the conference are determined (but not limited to) as:

Eco-Policy & Eco-Thinking

The methods to reach ecological awareness and ethics in terms of re-formulating the human conception of environment, discussing the consequences of human behavior etc., the role, content and methods of eco-centric education.

Ecologically Oriented Economics

Viewing the economic system as a subset of the broader ecosystem. New concepts of income measurement that reckon environmental pollution and natural resource depletion in calculating national income. New economic techniques based on the physical laws that govern energy and materials flows in ecosystem.

Industrial Ecology

Designing new industrial systems that follow a cyclical pattern by maximizing opportunities to recycle wastes at every point in the industrial production and consumption process.

Eco-technology

Examining eco-technologies in electricity, water and heat provision in terms of global warming.

Eco-planning

Natural resource management at national, regional and local levels, land use decisions, decision making and evaluation methods.

Eco-architecture

Ecological design, eco-construction technologies and building materials in architecture.

Global Climate Change

New techniques for the evaluation of technical, economic and political sides of the climate change arising from the greenhouse effect of heat-trapping gases and the effects of these changes on cities and health. Furthermore, the current land use patterns pave way for the cities of diverse sizes and varieties which contribute negatively on climate change.

Natural Resource Planning and Ecosystem Management

Conservation, biological and technical restoration, renewal methods in the context of sustainability of natural resources (catchment areas, forestry, agricultural lands etc.) and applied examples, case studies,

The international protocols and legal, technical norms for the protection of natural environment considering global environmental risks and new directions.
